This new material will make the notes more durable and also provide enhanced security features (not available on paper based notes). Will My Current Machine Count the New Polymer Notes

The new polymer bank notes have enhanced design and security features that are not compatible with many makes and models of currency counting equipment. Processing the new polymer bank notes will result in numerous false error codes for half note, and double note detection and potential for miscounting

Gemsys Upgrade Project

This is a National project that will have an effect on numerous makes and models of currency counting devices across the Country. Customers desiring to upgrade their existing equipment rather than replace with new, will need to complete an Inventory Confirmation Report (ICR) to enable Gemsys to determine their eligibility.
